Photo and Painting Contests 2022/23

Eligibility

- All participants should be NA students or NA affiliated staff.

Theme of the contests

- Harmony of Architecture and the Nature in CUHK

Categories

- 1) Photo group and 2) Painting group
- Participants can participate in one of the categories alone or in both categories

Registration and Deadline:

- Participants please complete the online registrations and submit entries on or before 17 March 2023.

Entry Requirements:

1) Photo group

- Photos could be taken with digital camera or mobile phone.
- The photo must be taken in CUHK campus from 2022 to 2023.
- The photo must be in JPEG format (.jpg) and 8 Megapixels or above. The photo size shall not exceed 5 MB.
- The photo could be produced with limited processing eg. adjust the photo's brightness and colour saturation, but not manipulate the content. Computer generated images or composite photos are strictly prohibited.
- Each participant can only submit one entry.
- Through the online registration, participant are required to submit a title for the photo (in both Chinese and English) and submit a description of the photo (in Chinese or English) not exceeding 30 words.
- All entries must be the original work. The participant must be the sole owner of the entire copyright in all entries entered and also ensure there is no infringement of any existing intellectual property rights. The organizer will not be held responsible for any consequences of rights infringement by the participants.
- All entries must not have been submitted for any other competition or provided to any party for any purpose before submitting to us.
- The decision of the Committee on Environmental Protection in all matters relating to these contests, including the selection of the winning submissions, is final.
- By joining the contests, the participants agree to accept that the College and the Committee on Environmental Protection has the right to display or publish the submitted works for use in any media (eg. College website, Facebook, Instagram or publication etc.).

2) Painting group

- Painting medium: Can be any (such as watercolor, oil, acrylic, drawing etc.) except digital graphics and photographs
- Painting dimensions: Must not be smaller than 30cm x 21cm AND must not exceed 70cm x 55cm
- All works are submitted via online registration. The work must be photographed completely from the "front" (The photo must be in JPEG format (.jpg) and 8 Megapixels or above. The photo size shall not exceed 5 MB), and the physical work must be properly preserved until the end of the contest.
- Each participant can only submit one entry.

- Through the online registration, participants are required to submit a title for the painting (in both Chinese and English) and submit a description of the painting (in Chinese or English) not exceeding 30 words.
- All entries must be the original work. The participant must be the sole owner of the entire copyright in all entries entered and also ensure there is no infringement of any existing intellectual property rights. The organizer will not be held responsible for any consequences of rights infringement by the participants.
- All entries must not have been submitted for any other competition or provided to any party for any purpose before submitting to us.
- The decision of the Committee on Environmental Protection in all matters relating to these contests, including the selection of the winning submissions, is final.
- By joining the contests, the participants agree to accept that the College and the Committee on Environmental Protection has the right to display or publish the submitted works for use in any media (eg. College website, Facebook, Instagram or publication etc.).

Selection Criteria:

- All entries will be assessed by the Committee based on the following criteria:
 - Composition
 - Aesthetic Sense
 - Creativity
 - Relevance to the theme

Awards:

- For each category of the contests, one 1st, 2nd and 3rd Award will be presented. The cash prizes are HK\$1,000, HK\$800 and HK\$600. There is also 7 Merit prizes with HK\$200 each. However, the committee reserve the right not to give awards if there is no suitable winners.
- Each winner could choose to be awarded with a certificate.

Results Announcement:

- The winning results will be announced on the college website in late-March 2023. Winners will also be notified by email individually.
