

Subsidy Scheme for Students' Inter-Cultural Exchange Initiative New Asia College

Goal:

This scheme aims to encourage more interactions between students of different backgrounds and nationalities of the College. By sponsoring student-initiated events and activities, we aim to promote mutual understanding, cultural appreciation and inclusivity. The open format is designed to stimulate creative activities that students are interested in exploring together.

Details of Activities:

It supports a wide range of student-initiated activities that facilitate meaningful interactions between students.

- The College is open to support any kind of socializing, artistic, musical, sport, or academic events. These may include but are not limited to meals, classes and workshops, performances etc.
- For example, cooking class, escape room, art jamming sessions, theater performances, local tours, etc.
- The event must involve both local Hong Kong students and non-local students from <u>three</u> different nationalities/regions.
- Only local activities will be considered.

Requirements:

To be eligible for reimbursement, an application must meet the following criteria:

- Each New Asia student can make a maximum of two applications per academic year.
- The same event should only be submitted once in an application.
- In a group of 5 to 15 undergraduate students, involving at least one local student and non-local students from <u>three</u> different nationalities/regions.
- At least half of the group members are New Asia students.
- Submission of 3 to 5 photos and a brief description of the activity via online application form for the College's Instagram or Facebook pages (whenever necessary) within one month of the activity.
- Submission of original receipts for reimbursement via online application form within one month of the activity. In the application form, please also give the names, student IDs and nationalities/regions of all participating students.

Reimbursement:

- Students could apply for reimbursement to cover expenses related to the activities, such as meals, admission tickets, workshop materials, etc.
- The maximum amount of reimbursement is <u>capped at HK\$100</u> per student and only the <u>actual expenses</u> shall be reimbursed.
