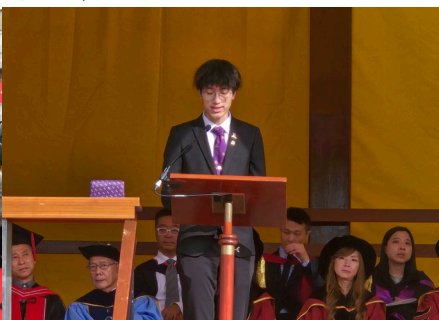

New Asia Young Scholars Scheme 2025/26



Introduction

This scheme aims to deepen students' understanding of College history and spirit, and empower them to become responsible individuals towards society as well as equip them with qualities that contemporary intellectuals and leaders should possess.

Selected students would have chances to participate in local/non-local historical trips, and are expected to participate in a series of training programme, such as training on communication skills, different kinds of workshops and various College activities. Students having fulfilled the requirements and with

outstanding performance will be named as “*New Asia Young Scholars*”, as well as receive a certificate and a scholarship from the College.

Requirements

- We welcome all New Asia students to apply. Preference will be given to non-graduating students in 2025/26
- Participants should be eager to promote College culture and interested in Chinese Culture
- During the programme period (23/8/2025-30/6/2026), participants are **not expected** to join any students exchange programme leaving Hong Kong for **more than one month**
- During the programme period (23/8/2025-30/6/2026), participants are **not expected** to join any off-campus internship programme for **more than two weeks**
